3. Minor Premiers 2001/2002 and the only side to beat the reigning premier side Hilton Park.

The 3rd eleven enjoyed moderate success this season finishing in the finals but unfortunately unable to recapture the brilliance which saw the boys finish minor premiers and win both the one day and two day premierships last season. Opener Craig Forsyth (402 runs @ 25.13) had a great year with the bat. Kevin Wade (22 wkt @ 15.31) again consistently bowled well and Stuart Buckby (fielding award) had another great year behind the stumps with 29 dismissals.

Other outstanding performances this season were Dan Hambleton (100 vs. Phoenix. Rd 3), Stephen Kirk (Hat Trick vs. Kardinya. Rd 9), Kevin Wade (7/30 vs. Roleystone. Rd 12) and Craig Grant (6/69 vs. Hilton Park. Semi-final).
