## Presidents Report – 2008 / 2009 Season

After the disappointment of not winning a premiership last season, it was a key focus of the club to improve our standing on the field and maintain a very competitive edge over all other clubs in the SMCA.

Off the field we celebrated our ninetieth year in grand style with a formal Gala Dinner at the Sheraton Hotel. One hundred and eighty current and former players/supporters attended a fantastic night. The highlights of the evening were many but I was particularly thrilled to see so many sponsors and life members there to enjoy what was truly a fantastic celebration. Brian Waterer's induction as a club "Legend" was also a major highlight. To this end, sincere congratulations and thank you to the organising committee who contributed considerable time and effort to make this function happen.

The club remains financially strong and considerable support from all of our 28 sponsors continues to amaze as their generosity in current financial times is overwhelming. Financially we are in a position to enter next season with confidence and we look forward to making all players and members even more comfortable and welcome with new and exciting initiatives planned.

To all members of the 2008 / 2009 committee, I sincerely thank you for all the work done throughout the season. Everyone should be extremely proud of their contribution as such commitment is the reason why we are in such a strong position both on and off the field. To those members not seeking reappointment, I trust you stay involved at the club as your contribution in any capacity is still required. It is also my understanding that Graeme Ashley and Brian Waterer are reducing their official involvement at the club and we cannot thank them enough for their very long and distinguished careers in the numerous roles played at the club. Obviously, they will be around next year but in a more relaxed capacity.

Matthew Smith, after spending the previous four years as club coach decided not to continue in that role and we therefore recruited the services of former WACA Willetton 1<sup>st</sup> grade player Paul Kalleske to fill the role. A special thank you to Matt for a very successful stint as club coach.

We had a mixed season on the field mainly through the unavailability of many senior players and this often stretched our resources to the limit, especially in the lower grades. Even as a result of this, we still managed to field seven sides every week. Special mention must go to the selectors and net coaches who spent many long hours looking for and counselling players after Thursday night selections. To the seven captains who took on numerous roles in addition to the captaincy, we thank you in what sometimes were difficult and trying circumstances.

In the end, four sides [1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and OD 'C's] made the finals, with the 1<sup>st</sup> grade and 6<sup>th</sup> grade sides making Grand finals and becoming Premiers. Season highlights included Gary Boyes becoming the seventh player to play three hundred games and Mick Bennett became the leading "5 for" wicket taker for the Club. Glenn Parise broke the Club batting record with 948 runs in a season and Brad Mant broke the individual club batting record for the highest innings score of 194 runs.

On a sad note, we say goodbye to Graeme and Tab Bond who have moved overseas to advance Graeme's professional career. We wish the Bond family well and hope to see them back at the Spartans in the future.

If re elected, my aim as club President is to make the 2009 / 2010 season even more successful both on and off the field and I know we look forward to next season with enthusiasm, looking to build upon our solid performance in all grades from this season.

## THE SEASON IN PRECIS:

After four successful years as Club Coach (including two First Grade Premierships) Matthew Smith decided not to continue and we recruited the services of former WACA Willetton 1<sup>st</sup> grade player Paul Kalleske to fill the role. A mixed season on the field – unavailability of many senior players stretched our resources to the limit in the lower grades, but we still managed to field seven sides each match. In the end four sides [1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> and OD 'C's'] made the four, with the 1sts and 6ths making Grand finals and becoming Premiers. Season highlights included Gary Boyes becoming the seventh player to play three hundred games and Mick Bennett became the leading "5 for" taker for the Club. A total of eighteen century partnerships were scored across the grades during the season. Nineteen hundreds were scored and twenty one "5 fors" were taken. Glenn Parise broke the batting club record [948] and Brad Mant broke the individual club batting record [194].

Off the field we celebrated our ninetieth year in grand style with a formal Gala Dinner at the Sheraton Hotel. One hundred and eighty current and former players/supporters attended a fantastic night. Finances continued to be strong as support from sponsors remained extremely good.

1<sup>st</sup> Grade:       **PREMIERS** [Captain Mark Atkinson] Completed a great season by winning the Premiership. Started the season the with a hiccup by losing to a depleted East Fremantle side, but didn't drop another game after that. Five batsmen scored in excess of three hundred runs, with Todd Lavender a stand out who opened the batting and got us off to a good start most games. Others over three hundred runs were Craig Periera, Mark Atkinson, Paul Kalleske and Matt Smith. Captain Mark Atkinson again led the bowling attack with 34 wickets, ably assisted by newcomer Anand Mavani (33), Will Badger (21) and another newcoming in Brett White (18).

2<sup>nd</sup> grade:       Chris Geers [Captain] Started with a blaze of glory but unfortunately faded in the second half to miss out of the finals. Played some good cricket but were not able to sustain it throughout the season. Captain Chris Geers led the batting with 392 runs {including a century}. Others over two hundred runs were Stuart Hennessey, Graeme Bond, "Mr Second Grade" Andrew Walker and Sean Wright {including his first century for the Club}. The bowling honours went to Nick Leavy with 25 wickets, assisted by Sean Wrrght and the ever reliable Andrew Wragg.

3<sup>rd</sup> Grade:       Shannon Davies [Captain] Had a great season, finishing on top of the ladder and winning the One Day Premiership. Unfortunately couldn't take their winning form into the finals and lost the semi final to Cockburn. Andrew Gibbs had a fantastic season with 792 runs {including two centuries} and 22 wickets. Others in the runs were John McGuire (521) {including two centuries}, with Kevin Poller, Adam Seaward and Glenn Hack all over 200 runs. Captain Shannon Davies led the bowling with 26 wickets. Ben Rushton, Kevin Poller and Andrew Gibbs all took over twenty wickets.

5<sup>th</sup> Grade:       Bill Greenshields/John Ipsen [Captain] Remained competitive throughout the season but absences in higher grades robbed this side of any chance of finals glory. Were often fighting "above their weight", playing the higher sides from other clubs. Eventual captain John Ipsen had a good season opening the batting and scored 374 runs, with super recruit Sam Vellios getting over two hundred, along with Jeremy Gibson. Seve Murfitt and new player Chris Rajandra shared the bowling honours.

6<sup>th</sup> Grade:       **PREMIERS** Gary Boyes [Captain] Although sometimes a bit inconsistent they made the final four and went on to defeat Phoenix, who had gone through the season undefeated. Sweet revenge, as Phoenix had won the One Day Final by a narrow margin. Some great individual performances – Brad Mant broke the individual club batting record in scoring 194 and Wayne Fontana won the Read/Waterer Club Champion Medal. Wayne Fontana had a dominant season scoring 857 runs {including three hundreds} and taking 53 wickets {including 7/53}. Brad Mant scored 672 {including two hundreds} and Peter Ferguson and Dave Abercrombie were over three hundred runs. Dave Abercrombie and Mick Bennett ably assisted Fontana with the bowling. Mick Bennett took 3 "5 fors" and became the leading "5 for" taker for the Club.

OD 'A' Grade:   Blake Carter [Captain] Played a very competitive season, eventually just missing the finals. Had a great victory over nemesis Kenwick and were consistent in most games, whilst not quite matching it with the top sides. Graeme Tysoe opened the batting with distinction and made 367 runs, with Matt Scarterfield and Captain Blake Carter over three hundred runs. Beau Carter was the best performed bowler with 26 wickets, assisted by Kyle Salzmann and Blake Carter.

OD 'C' Grade:   Damian Halden [Captain] Undefeated during the season, but unfortunately once again the finals proved their undoing, losing to Thornlie in the semi-final. Despite this loss a great season and some excellent individual performances. Glenn Parise scored 804 runs {including three hundreds} and took 37 wickets. Rob Blazeovich got 433 runs and took 39 wickets. Dale Putland made 405 runs {including his first century for the Club}. Captain Damian Halden and newcomer Travis Fryers scored over three hundred runs. Paul Petkovich scored the fifth hundred in the team. The bowling was dominated by Blazeovich and Parise, assisted by Paul Phillips and Darren Humble.



## ***THE PREMIERSHIP TEAMS:*** ***FIRST GRADE PREMIERS 2008/09***

Defeated Armadale in a final worthy of its 1st grade status. Spartans batted first and were in immediate trouble, losing Todd Lavender to the second ball of the day and Darren Rose soon after to be at a precarious 2/2. Steady batting by Matt Smith (39) and Craig Pereira (27) got things back on track and a good partnership between Smith and Paul Kalleske (35) followed by some good hitting at the end by Dale Meyer (35) and Mark Atkinson (39no) - and a great six by Shane Thompson ! saw us make a very competitive 6/196. Although Armadale applied themselves to the run chase and ensured the final was a closer affair than some might have thought they lost wickets at regular intervals and were eventually out for 121. Will Badger took the bowling figures with 4/42, assisted by Mark Atkinson 3/28. In all a great team effort all season and the 1st grade are well deserving Premiers for the 2008/09 season.

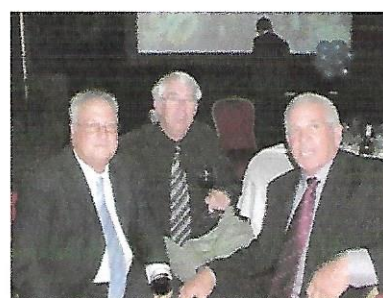
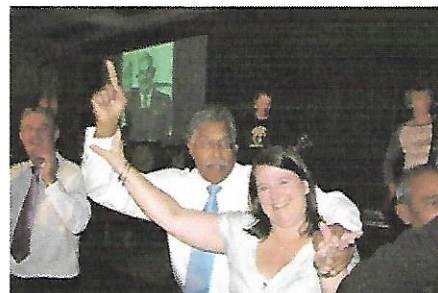
## OTHER FINALISTS .....
